Finally -- The Chance to Say What You've Been Dying to Get Off Your Chest, But Have Been Afraid to Say; New Service Now Allows You to Express Yourself through TheAnonymousEmail.com

What would you say if you could say anything to anybody at any time -- and not have to worry about whether the recipient of your message knew that it came from you?

It could be an insult, a complaint, a suggestion, a flirtation, a prank or just plain gossip, but chances are that you've got something you would really like to say to somebody today.

However, concerns for personal repercussions are probably holding you back. Introducing TheAnonymousEmail.com, an online communication service for sending masked e-mail messages.

The Suggestion Box, Inc., headquartered in Scottsdale, Ariz., announces the launch of TheAnonymousEmail.com, a service created to provide the 81 percent of Americans who send e-mail on a daily basis with an opportunity to send informational, suggestive and opinion-based messages to another e-mail address without disclosing the sender's identity.

An annual subscription of \$24.95 allows access to a service where users can send an unlimited number of masked messages. Those who subscribe to the site now can take advantage of an introductory discount of \$19.95 for the annual service, which ends up costing less than six cents per day.

As a therapeutic outlet, a desire to take action, or simply for fun, the site provides users with 13 categories of messages and more than 130 specific message ideas they can send to unsuspecting recipients. Total confidentiality of the sending party is guaranteed, and message recipients can respond to anonymous e-mails, although they won't know who sent the unidentified e-mail.

"Everybody, I mean everybody has something they want to get off their chest today. This universal desire was the inspiration behind creating the service," said Howard R. Baer, founder of TheAnonymousEmail.com.

"This site can be a tool to improve other's bad behavior, encourage their good behavior, or help you feel an amazing amount of power to finally say what's been on your mind. Having the chance to speak out without negative repercussions is a great stress reliever. And it's a lot cheaper than therapy," he added.

In addition to the site being used for self-expression, the creators of TheAnonymousEmail.com are encouraging subscribers to send anonymous tips to legal authorities, the media or school authorities.

TheAnonymousEmail.com site is structured to enable the subscriber to send a message through the company's server, where the message drops the subscriber's identity. A random code is then generated for that individual message, and sent to the recipient from the server without disclosing the identity or Internet Protocol address of the sender.

The recipient has the option to reply or simply block the sender. If the recipient chooses to reply to the sender, the dialogue may continue as long as a new message is sent from the subscriber. Additionally, the sender can log on to the web site to find out if the recipient has opened the email message. If for some reason, after seven days the recipient has not opened the email, upon request TheAnonymousEmail will redirect the message to the recipient through the United States Postal Service, a.k.a. Snail Mail.

"It's still illegal to send a threat or to stalk someone via e-mail," Baer said. "If these guidelines are not followed, offenders will be banned from the site and could get reported to legal authorities. Although we hope that no one chooses to use the site for these purposes, we've implemented safeguards against this. But by the same token, wouldn't you just love to tell somebody exactly what you're thinking today without the fear of being caught?"

By logging on to the site at TheAnonymousEmail.com, users can send a free test message to themselves to see how the service works before enrolling.

TheAnonymousEmail.com is exclusively for the use of subscribers 18 years or older.
