When a person sends an email through <http://www.TheAnonymousEmail.com>, it's actually sent out by the company servers and does not carry the IP number of the sender.

The company stated that they have received many emails from third world countries indicating that the writers were interested in meeting people in other countries and learning their cultures. With the ability to correspond anonymously and translate to other languages, we are basically "bringing the world together. "
